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Barbara K. Burton, MD, is an Attending Physician in the Division of Genetics, Birth Defects, and Metabolism at the Ann & Robert H. Lurie Children's Hospital of Chicago and directs the Mucopolysaccharidosis/Mucopolipidosis (MPS/ML) Treatment Program. She is also a Professor of Pediatrics at the Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine.

She has extensive experience in the treatment of both children and adults with inborn errors of metabolism (IEM) and lysosomal storage disorders (LSD). She is the past President of the Chicago Pediatric Society and past President of the Society for Inherited Metabolic Disorders. She has served for many years as a consultant to the Newborn Screening Program of the Illinois Department of Public Health and is Chairman of the Newborn Screening Advisory Committee. Dr Burton has contributed over 200 articles and book chapters to medical literature and has been an investigator for the clinical trials of many new therapies, including the clinical trials of enzyme replacement therapy for MPS IVA.
